



Land Acknowledgement (Toronto)

The land we are meeting on is the traditional and unceded territory of many nations including the Mississaugas of the Credit, the Anishinabek, the Chippewa, the Haudenosaunee and the Wendat peoples, as well as those peoples not in the written record—and is also at present home to many diverse First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples.

We acknowledge the genocide and inter-generational trauma inflicted by the colonizers here-- and that it is the responsibility of non-Indigenous governments to end the cycle of violence, to make reparations and commit to Land Back for the conservation of Indigenous ancestral lands in Toronto and across Ontario.
